Why Choose RI?

1

Dharma: Sanatana teaches living a righteous life according to their duties (dharma). Children learn about ethical behaviour, compassion, and respect for all living beings.

Festivals: Bright Diwali, Colourful Holi, Auspicious Ganesh Chaturthi, Nine nights of Navaratri, and so many festivals are celebrated all year around. Children learn about the significance of these festivals.

Seva: Service to others (seva) is encouraged. Children learn values and importance of community service projects.

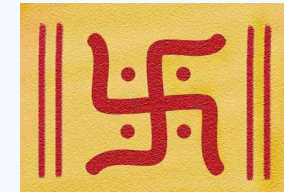
Samskara: Hindu RI Classes provide children with a holistic understanding of Hinduism, fostering spiritual growth, cultural awareness, and respect for diversity.

How do I select RI?

RI is offered from Year 1 onwards and you can choose RI:

- **When enrolling** in your local school by nominating "Yes" on the enrolment form for your child to participate. You can then nominate which RI you want your child placed in, if it is available at the school.*
- **Any time via a written instruction** to your school Principal.
